Strong winds continue to affect Barbados this afternoon and are expected to persist overnight, with higher gusts near showers. Therefore the High Wind Advisory has been extended into the night.

Possible Impacts

Expect tumbling or rolling of unsecured objects such as inflatable structures, tents and garbage cans. Trees could be blown down along with large branches and power lines.

The public is encouraged to monitor the BMS, DEM and GIS websites and their respective social media pages along with the local media networks for further information on what you should do.

Discussion

The Atlantic high-pressure system continued to generate winds of 20 to 30 knots (35 to 55km/h) across Barbados this afternoon with wind gusts up to 45 knots reported. With shower activity expected overnight, there is the possibility for higher wind gusts overnight.

General Information

A high-wind advisory is issued when sustained winds of 25 to 33 knots (47 to 61km/h) are affecting or forecast to affect the land area within 36 hours. The High Wind Advisory was updated at 6 pm today Wednesday June 11th and will be updated/terminated at 6 am Thursday 12th June 2025 or sooner if conditions warrant.
