Discussion

A strengthening Atlantic High-pressure system is dominant across Barbados and the region. Moderate to strong winds of 20 to 30 knots (37 to 56 km/h), associated with this feature are affecting the island. Additionally, higher gusts are expected near showers.

General Information

A high-wind advisory is issued when sustained winds of 25 to 33 knots (47 to 61km/h) are affecting or forecast to affect the land area within 36 hours. This High-wind Advisory was issued at 10:00 am, Tuesday, 11th February 2025 and will be updated at noon, Wednesday, 12th February, 2025.
